About the Conference

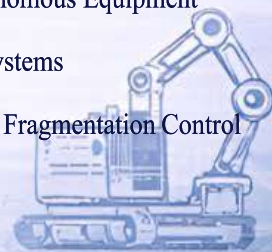

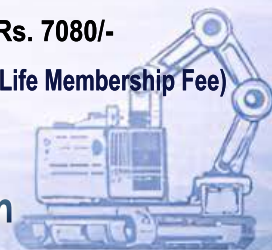
